Passengers bringing plants (including fruits, vegetables, and seeds) or animals (including hams, sausages, and other meat products) into Japan must have them inspected at the Plant and Animal Quarantine counter.

5: Customs Inspection

All passengers must submit a Customs Declaration form on arrival. Please write down what you have purchased overseas as well as any gifts and items you have brought into Japan on this form. Passengers with unaccompanied baggage or items must submit two Customs Declaration forms.

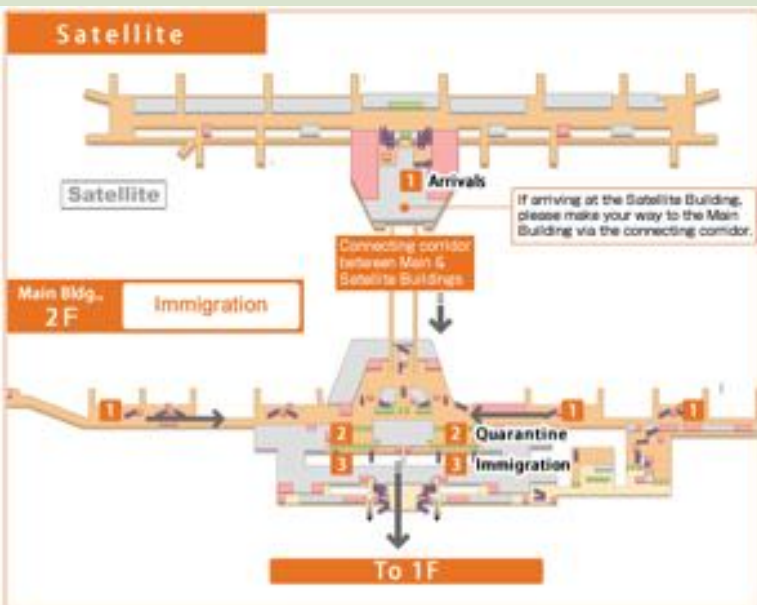

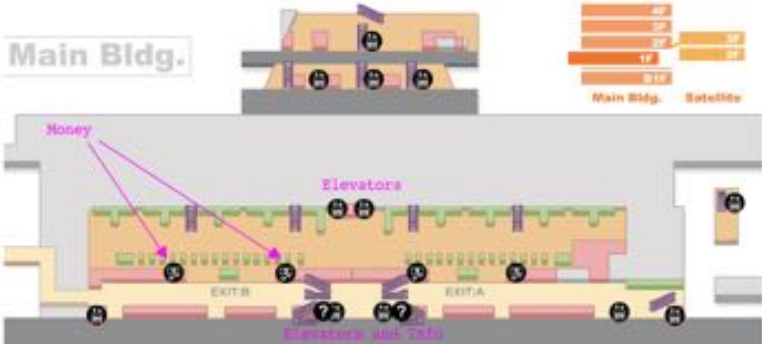

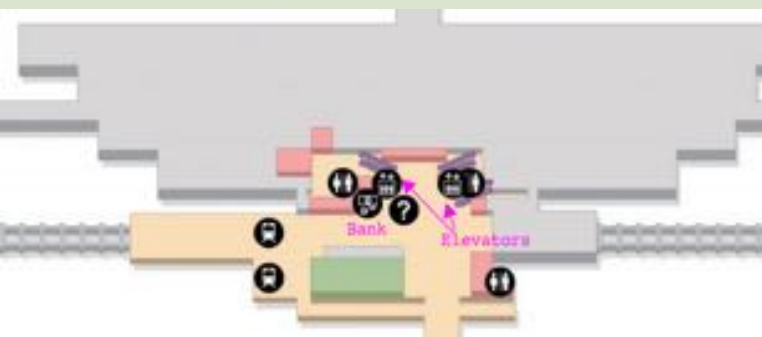
